Which of the experiences listed below is your company willing to participate in? If your interest or abilities change, you can change your preferences at any time.



- Company Tours** | *In-person or virtual tours for students or school staff.*
- Informational Interviews** | *Not a job interview, but an informational meeting to find out more about a specific career.*
- Career/Job Fair Booth** | *Host a table and speak with students about careers at your company.*
- Career Discovery Meetings** | *30-45 minute presentations about your career path or industry.*
- Panel Discussion** | *Take part in a panel discussion about your career/industry.*
- Job Shadow** | *Student observes an employee for a short period of time (typically 1 day).*
- Mock Interview** | *Company interviews a student as practice for future job interviews.*
- Mentorship/Skills Coaching** | *Mentor a student for one-on-one soft skills coaching and career development.*
- Project Embedded into High School Curriculum** | *Your company works with a teacher to develop a work-based learning project that is incorporated into the curriculum.*
- Micro-Internship** | *Student works at a company for a short defined time period (could be as short as 1 week) for career exploration & skill development. Can be paid or unpaid.*
- Rotating-Internship** | *Students perform 9-week rotating internships with 4 different companies/organizations. Can be paid or unpaid.*
- Internship** | *Student intern works at a company for a defined time period (typically 1-2 semesters) for career exploration, job experience, skill development, and networking. Recommended paid, can be unpaid.*
- Apprenticeship** | *On the job training with accompanying study for trade/profession resulting in an industry certification with wage increases along the way. Student is paid.*
